If you are a new student and have applied for a graduate research course by the <u>course application closing date</u> (https://futurestudents.unimelb.edu.au/admissions/dates) for the relevant faculty, school or course, you will be automatically considered for the Graduate Research Scholarships. You will receive a notification that a scholarship application has been added to your record within 7 days of having submitted your course application.

If you have accepted a graduate research course offer and deferred commencement in order to be re-considered for a scholarship, you must submit an <u>online application form</u>

(https://unimelb_scholarships.formstack.com/forms/graduate_research_scholarships_application) by the course application closing date (https://futurestudents.unimelb.edu.au/admissions/dates) for the relevant faculty or school. You will receive a notification that a scholarship application has been added to your record within 7 days of having submitted the online form.

If you are currently enrolled in a graduate research course for which you seek a scholarship, you must submit an <u>online application form</u>

× When will I know the outcome?

Domestic students will receive an offer for Research Training Program Scholarship (Fee Offset) as part of their course offer.

Offers for Graduate Research Scholarships that provide a stipend and fee offset are made separately but around the same time course offers are made.

Melbourne Research Scholarships (MRS)

This scholarship is available to high achieving domestic and international students undertaking a Master by research degree or Doctoral degree.

Australian Government Research Training Program (RTP) Scholarships Provided by the Australian Commonwealth Government, this scholarship is available to high achieving domestic and international students undertaking a Master by research degree or Doctoral by research degree. WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS?

Stipend and fee offset scholarships

- Full fee offset for up to 2 years for students undertaking a Master by research degree or up to 4 years for students undertaking a Doctoral degree.
- Living allowance of \$30,000 per year pro rata (2018 full-time study rate) for up to 2 years for students undertaking a Master by research degree or up to 3.5 years for students undertaking a Doctoral degree. The living allowance may be indexed annually and includes limited paid sick, maternity and parenting leave.
- Relocation grant of \$2,000 for students moving from States or Territories other than Victoria or \$3,000 for students moving from outside Australia.
- Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) Single Membership for international students who require a student visa to study in Australia

Fee offset scholarships

 Full fee offset for up to 2 years for students undertaking a Master by research degree or up to 4 years for students undertaking a Doctoral degree.
