## Research Scholarship

Bond University is committed to providing a high level HDR experience to ensure success in students' research and research training. The provision of appropriate financial support is an important part of the research training environment. Bond University allocates funds to support the financial costs of fee offset (waiver) and living stipends.

The HDR Scholarship rounds are held twice a year:

- › 1st February - 31st March
- › 1st August - 28th September

The University places a focus on commencing full time on campus Doctoral students only for living stipend scholarships. Masters students are not eligible to apply for HDR Scholarships.

- › The 2018 full-time stipend rate will be \$27,082.00 per annum (indexed annually)

### Before you apply for a PhD scholarship: Steps 1 - 4

---

The first 3 steps in the application process below must be completed prior to lodging your Scholarship application (Step 4)

- › These steps 1 - 3 will take 4-6 weeks to complete
  - › *You must allow sufficient time before the Scholarship application closure date*
- › **Step 1** - Expression of interest (EOI) to Faculty
- › **Step 2** - Find a Supervisor
- › **Step 3** - Apply for Admission to Bond University

- › **Step 3** - Apply for Admission to Bond University
- › **Step 4** - Apply for Scholarship: [Assessment of Scholarship applications framework](#)<sup>1</sup>
  - › You must have received a Letter of Offer for Admission to Bond University
  - › You must apply using the [online SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM](#)<sup>2</sup>

If you have previously applied for a scholarship at Bond University, and were **unsuccessful**, you are **not** eligible to re-apply. *Late or incomplete Scholarship applications received after 28th September 2018 will not be considered in this Round.*

Your first step is to lodge a [HDR Expression of Interest](#)<sup>3</sup>.

Once your Expression of Interest has been accepted, you will be required to make an application for admission to a HDR Doctoral program through the relevant Faculty.

The Australian Government Research Training Program (RTP) stipends are provided to support the general living costs of both domestic and overseas students undertaking Research Doctorate degrees.

**Opening date:** Now open for September 2018 Scholarship Round.

- › Closes 5pm EST on 28th September 2018
- › *Late or incomplete Scholarship applications received after 28th September 2018 will not be considered.*

## Scheme and description

A limited number of scholarships are available to domestic and overseas DOCTORAL students who wish to continue their education through a PhD program. The RTP scholarship is awarded through a competitive application processes. Bond University HDR Scholarships Committee meets biannually to award fee waivers and living stipends based on a merit based selection process. Students cannot apply if they are receiving an equivalent award or scholarship from the Commonwealth designed to offset HDR fees.

**Eligibility:** The scholarship application process is open to domestic and overseas HDR students who are studying, or intend on studying, a PhD Doctorate by Research at Bond University.
